

Location

Hours of Operation

The high school program operates on two shifts. The morning shift is from 7:10 a.m. to 9:40 a.m. The afternoon shift is from 11:50 noon to 2:20 p.m. George T. Baker Aviation Technical College students are considered shared timed students with their home school.

Programs

High school students may enroll in the following programs: Aerospace Technology (9th graders), Avionics, Aircraft Maintenance Mechanic Programs. High school students may earn one Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Aircraft Maintenance Technician certificate at the end of the 3 years at George T. Baker Aviation Technical College. The additional FAA certification may be earned through the post-secondary program.

Requirements

The George T. Baker Aviation Technical College calendar runs on the Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) Elementary/ Secondary School Calendar.

Students who are accepted at George T. Baker Aviation Technical College must have a 2.0 GPA, passing End-of-Course Exams, and superior attendance, conduct, and effort. All George T. Baker Aviation Technical College dual enrolled students are considered Career Dual Enrolled students.

Students will complete the following examinations throughout their time at George T. Baker Aviation Technical College: School Qualifying Exam, FAA Written Exams for General, Airframe or Powerplant (A&P) licenses or FCC examinations for Avionics (Electronics) certificates.

Students are accepted from all M-DCPS, Charter Schools, Private Schools, and Home Schools.

Transportation

M-DCPS Transportation is provided to those who qualify.

Dress for the Job

George T. Baker Aviation Technical College has an enhanced dress code that reflects the appropriateness of the student's attire for their chosen profession in the aviation industry. Health and safety requirements are enforced to ensure student safety in both the classroom and shop environments and to prepare students for dress and safety codes on the job. Students are required to wear their George T. Baker Aviation Technical College ID's at all times while on campus.

Student-Parent Contract/Offer of Acceptance

All students, at the time of acceptance, must sign a contract agreeing to follow the rules and policies of George T. Baker Aviation Technical College and M-DCPS. In addition, high school students must have the permission and signature of their parent/legal guardian. Failure to respond to an offer of acceptance by an adult student or parent/legal guardian of a high school student within the specified time frame will render the application outcome as a refusal. The minimum required time is one (1) year of attendance.

Closed High School Campus

George T. Baker Aviation Technical College is a closed campus. Students who qualify are provided with free or reduced breakfast and/or lunch.

Student Activities

Students may become members of the Technology Student Association (TSA), SkillsUSA, the Vocational National Honor Society (VNHS), Aviation Explorers, Electronics Club, or Cyber Patriots. These organizations promote leadership, personal growth, and technical skills. Members of TSA, SkillsUSA, and VNHS compete in local, state, regional, and national competitions throughout the school year. The organization host fund raisers and community service projects to meet stated goals.
